- Create an illustrated blog about your international experience, including text and photos, and consisting of at least fifteen separate entries.
- Give a PowerPoint presentation (10-15 minutes in length) about your international experience at an event approved in advance by the Honors Dean.
- Prepare a poster (28" x 38", including photos, maps, and a narrative) about your international experience.
