# What is Mozilla Popcorn?

- Popcorn.js is an HTML5 media framework written in JavaScript
- It allows you to create layers of interactive content on top of a video

# Popcorn Maker

- **Popcorn.js** = framework underneath the project
- **Popcorn Maker** = graphical interface used to create the project – web-based, no software to download

## It all starts with a Video

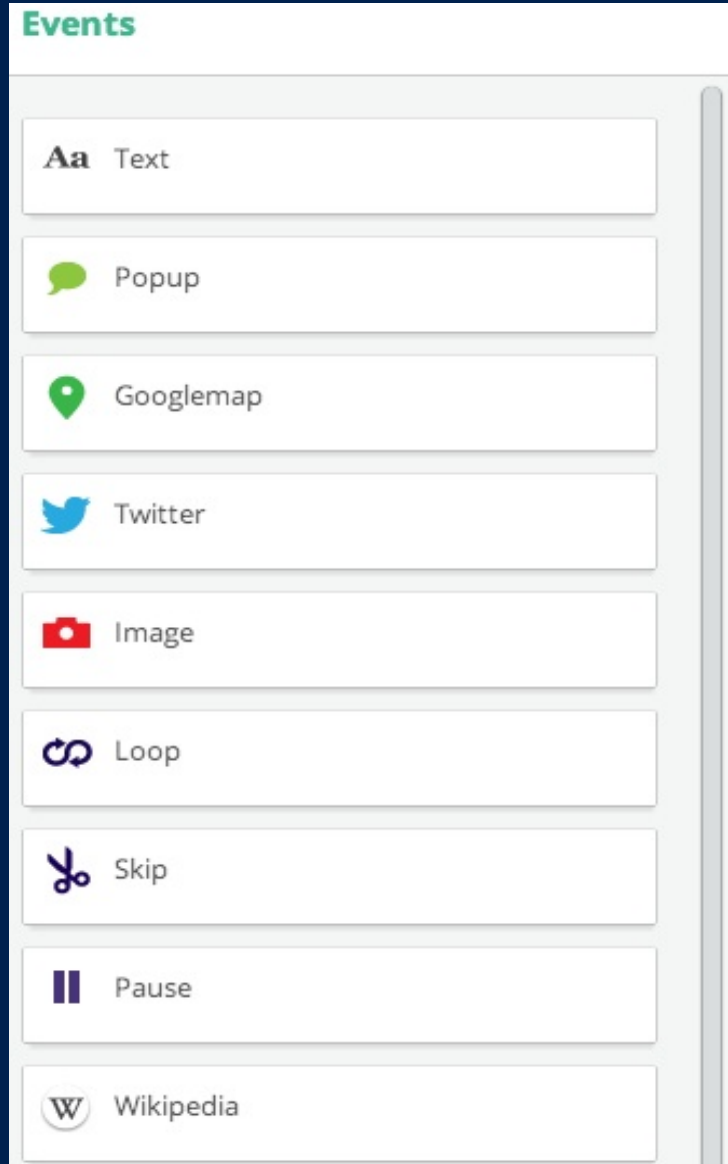
- For this project, you will be using a video you create
  - Publish to YouTube
  - Get “Share this video” URL (Ex. <http://youtu.be/J4G8t4ThoqE>)
  - Use that as your Media in Popcorn Maker
- What type of content would compliment your topic (in addition to your video)?



# Events

Events = Layers of content on top of your video

- Text
- Popup
- Googlemap
- Twitter
- Image
- Loop, Skip, Pause
- Wikipedia

  - Make sure you are logged in
- Start a New Project
- Use this video as “Media”
- Add “Events”
- Save and Embed your Project Video
