

Effective January 19, 2016:

- Any student purchases should be for use in the current semester, or may be for use in the upcoming semester with proper justification and approval. ICSSP leadership must approve any exceptions.
- Equipment purchases are the property of the University and must be returned when the student graduates from the program or terminates their involvement in the ICSSP program.
- One-half of your professional development and book stipends will be made available per semester, with no carryover at the end of the academic year. (Academic years are from August to May.)
- Travel to annual SFS job fair is required by the scholarship program and will be allocated from your personal development funds.
- Professional development funds may be used to attend professional or academic-sponsored conferences or seminars. Students should submit a proposal to the ICSSP program, which is to include the conference agenda as well as justification for how attendance at the conference will benefit the ICSSP program. The student will be expected to present at ICSSP seminar to share information learned. (P.I. approval will be required prior to registration.)
- Professional development funds may be used to obtain professional certifications related to cybersecurity. P.I. approval will be required prior to registration. Reimbursement will occur after submission of proof of successful completion of the professional certification.
