1. PRESENTATION/ DELIVERY	Has natural delivery; opening statement catches attention; summarizes main points; modulates voice; projects enthusiasm, interest, and confidence; uses body language effectively	Short/vague opening statement; somewhat organized; has appropriate pace and has no distracting mannerisms; volume is understood; provides vague "road map"; comfortable body language	Has no opening statement or irrelevant statement; scattered throughout the poster; is often hard to understand; voice is too soft or too loud; pace too quick or too slow; demonstrates one or more distracting mannerism(s)	
2. CONTENT	Poster is comprehensive and very organized; has superior section content (e.g., introduction, results, conclusions, etc.); has appropriate sources	Adequate coverage of topic; poster is mostly complete but missing some key details/content in some sections; some sources	Does not give adequate coverage of topic; missing major details/content in some or many sections; lacks sources	
3. VISUAL	Figures, schemes, diagrams, and tables properly used; font size large enough; figures & drawings enhance presentation	Figures, schemes, diagrams, and tables challenging to follow; font size not large enough in some areas; figures & drawings hard to depict	Figures, schemes, diagrams, and tables not interpretable; font size too small in whole poster; figures & drawings confuse/contradict presentation	
4. CLARITY	Minimal use of jargon; defines concepts well; succinct, to the point explanations; clearly explains significance of research	Uses some jargon; defines most concepts; some long - winded answers; vague explanation of significance of research	Excessive use of undefined jargon; lengthy & inconsequential explanations; does not explain significance of research
