Keys to Success

Make your group sessions engaging

- Welcome students to the session
- Be enthusiastic
- Include time for both presentation and Q+A
- Come prepared with FAQs in case you need icebreakers

Keys to Success

Build in accountability for your team

- Registration is not complete until your team claims their schedule
 - Send reminder emails to your team
 - **Check** to see if they've claimed their schedule
 - Send follow-ups
- Students will not be able to view or select sessions before the slots are claimed
 - **Student registration opens February 14**


