## Terrestrial Game Hunter Harvest Log

### How to assemble your booklet:

1. Place first page face-down on the table
2. Place second page face-up on top of page 1
3. Stack record pages face-up on top of page 2
4. Fold along the center line located on page 1
5. Staple along center line to keep pages together (optional)

How to use this booklet:

1. Make sure you are within the regulations for each area and species. Hunting regulations by area and species can be found at:

2. Fill out the date and location each time you go afield hunting or wildlife watching.
3. Indicate how many of what species you observed and/or harvested by date.
4. This record will help you keep track of information that needs to be reported in the post-season hunter harvest survey distributed by IDNR.
5. Print more record pages as needed and add them to your booklet.
6. Use the last page in this booklet (blank) to record notes like weather, behavior, and other things worth noting.
7. Keeping records like this is a good way to ensure accurate reporting for check stations or surveys.
