


















AVMA PLIT - Veterinary Student Professional Liability Insurance

- · As a veterinary student, you get to partake in countless hands-on experiences that provide invaluable opportunities for learning and growth. These expose veterinary students yound malpractice risks. Being financially supported in the event of a medical mistance is crucial. AVMA PLIT provides students liability coverage for the entire duration of their veterinary school, and keeps students safe during clinicals, externships, and other experiences that occur outside of school
- Student liability limits are \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$200,000,000 annual aggregate.
