

State of Illinois still has no budget for FY 16



University has not received any budget news

- July 1 was the start of the new fiscal year
- Governor Rauner and the General Assembly are still in budget negotiations
- The University Deans worked with campus leadership to develop some preliminary budgetary numbers for planning purposes



Total Preliminary University Library Reduction


\$877,962

Library was provided some reduction relief

- ~\$17m Materials was excluded from reductions
- ~\$10m Library/IT Fee was excluded from reductions
- Budget Reductions:
 - \$603,000 FY 16 Budget Reduction
 - \$23,746 CITES/CIO extraordinary IT investment allocation
 - \$55,826 TOP/Spousal*
 - \$195,390 Facilities (utilities) and other common costs*
 - *Library was only assessed at ½ the rate for other units on campus taxes
- Total FY 16 reduction= \$877,962
- Tentative FY 16 University Library Budget = \$42,053,635


