

Geoffrey C. Bowker is professor at the Donald Bren School of Information and Computer Sciences and Director of the Values in Design Laboratory at the University of California, Irvine. From 1993-1998, he was faculty at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign's School of Information Sciences (formerly the Graduate School of Library and Information Science), and was a faculty affiliate of the National Center for Supercomputing Applications from 1998-1999. He currently codirects the NSF-funded Council for Big Data, Ethics, and Society with researchers from across academia and the IT industry. He has published widely on the topics of information infrastructure, classification systems in distributed scientific collaborations, and the use of web and digital resources across disciplines.
