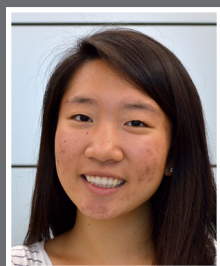
Are you an Illinois undergraduate looking for your next internship experience?
