- Submission of a letter of recommendation from a faculty or staff member. The letter should address academic performance and vision, perseverance, and commitment to your chosen field.
- An essay (not to exceed 500 words) which addresses each of the following topics:
  - The impact of your participation in extracurricular activities
  - Your future educational, professional, and personal goals
  - How this scholarship will impact your educational goals
