FOR LIBRARIES

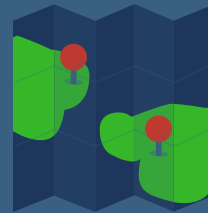
Refugees coming to the US are resettled by R&P Agencies and are assigned housing near their local office.

SEARCH

- Search for your address in Google.
- Click on "Maps".
- Click on "Nearby" and type in "public library".
- On the left, the search will list the libraries in order of how close they are to your location.



EXPLORE

- On the map, your location and nearby libraries will appear. To explore more libraries, zoom out by clicking the "-" sign.
- Click a library to view the address, hours, and website.



CONNECT

- On the library website, search, discover, and determine the library services and resources that best suit your needs.
- Visit your friendly local public library!
