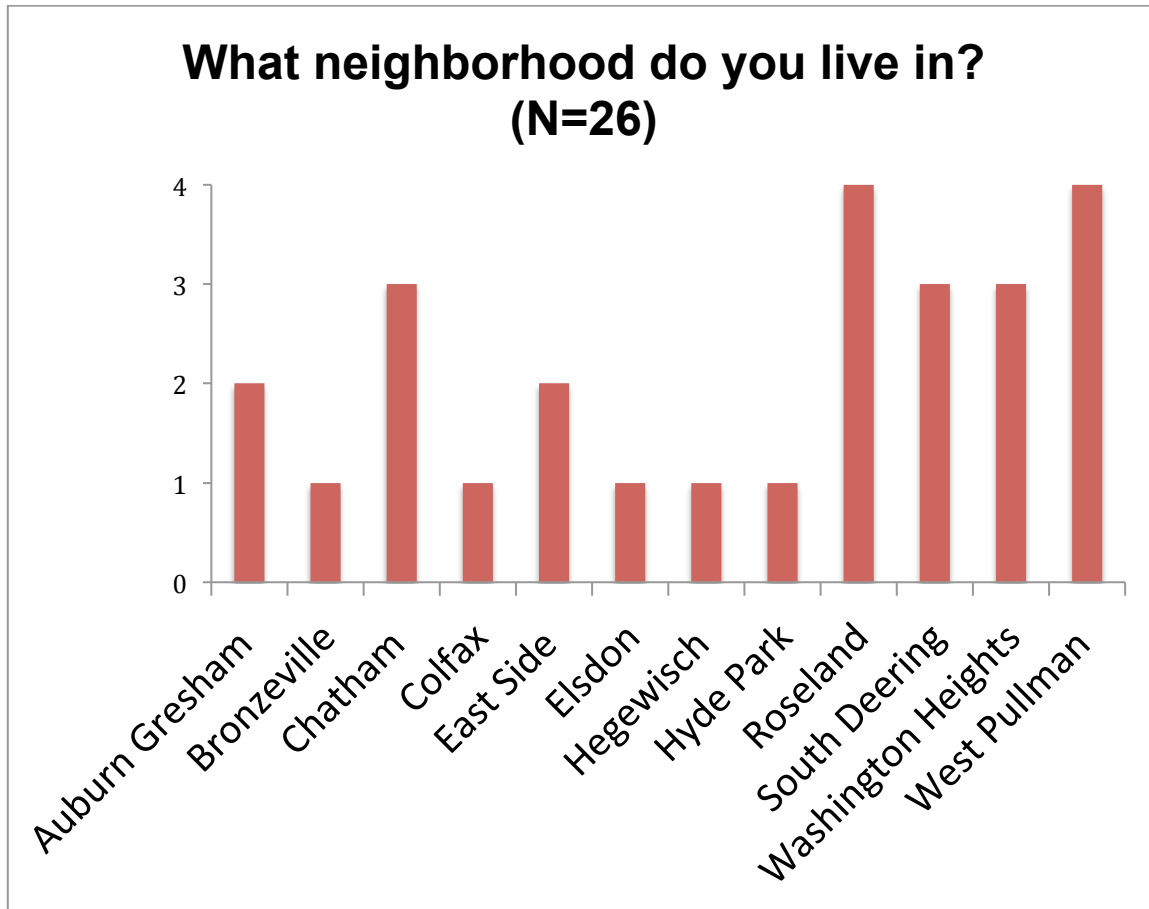

Do you have a job? (N=30)

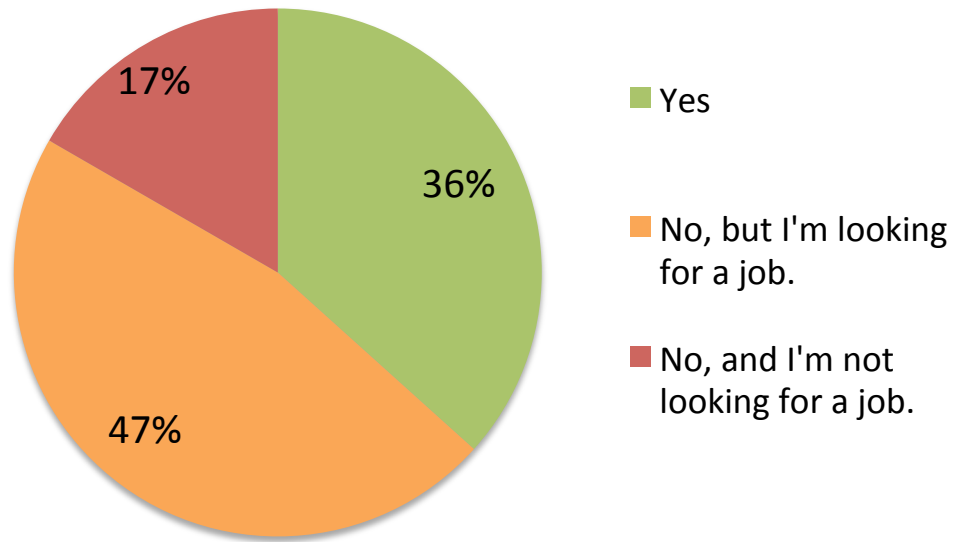


Chart 2

How do you usually get to school? Select all that apply. (N=31)

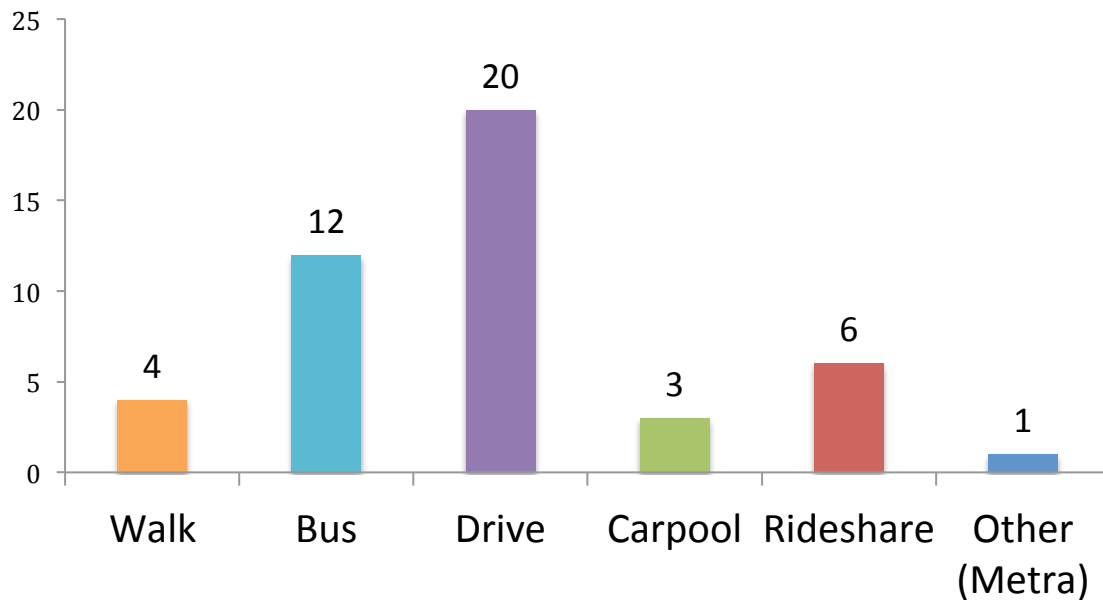

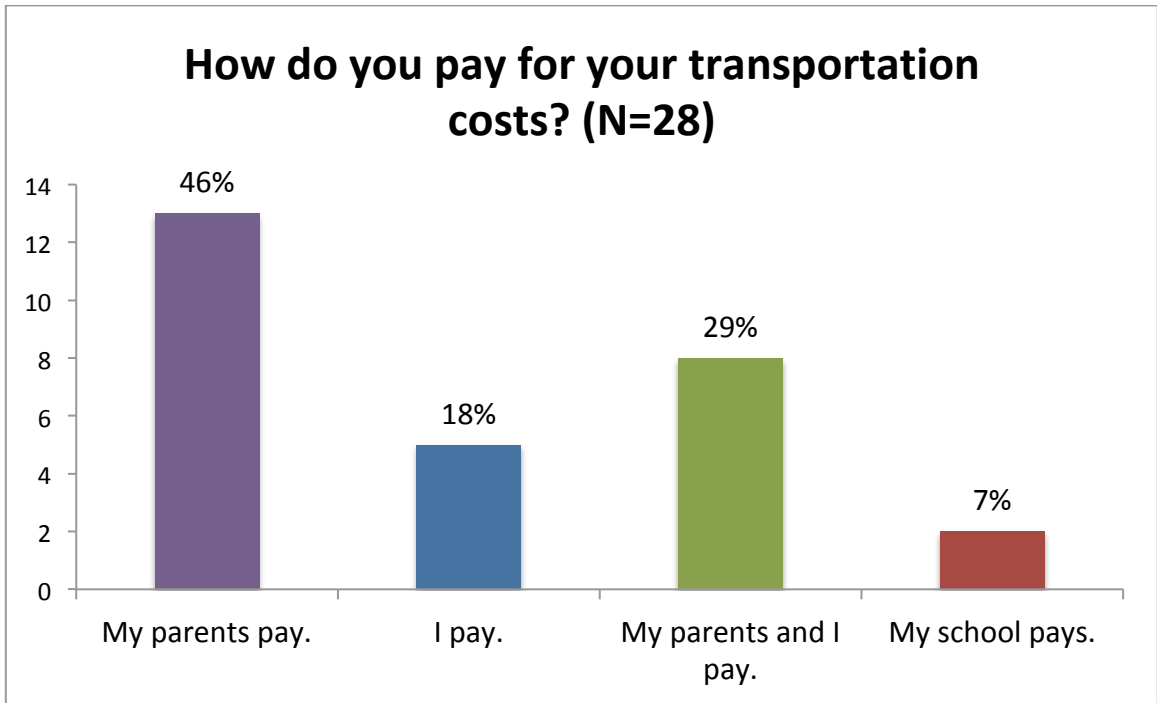

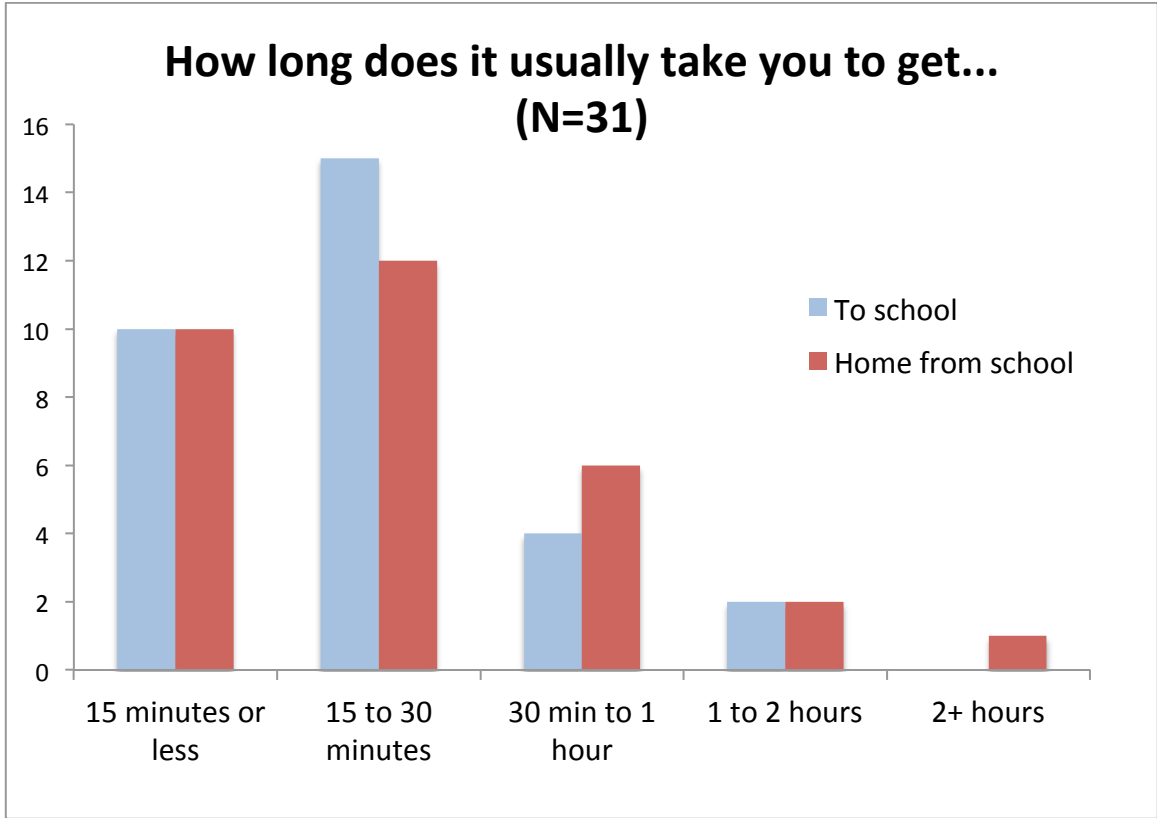

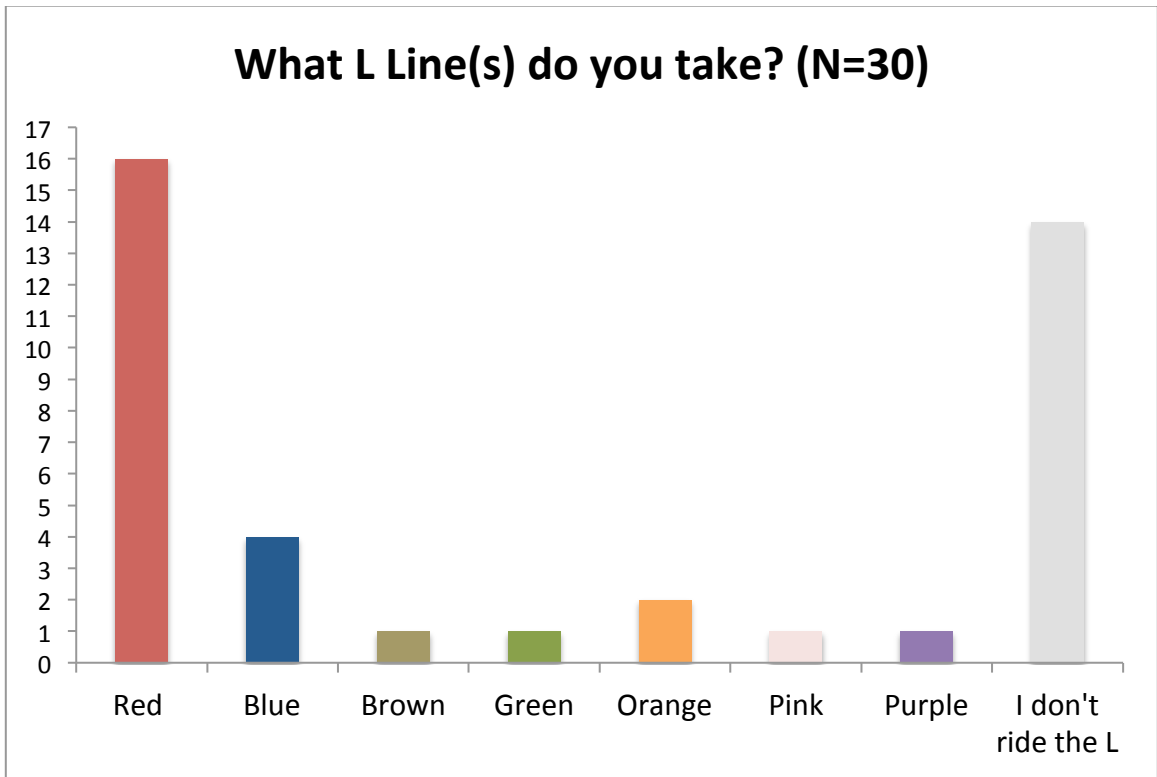

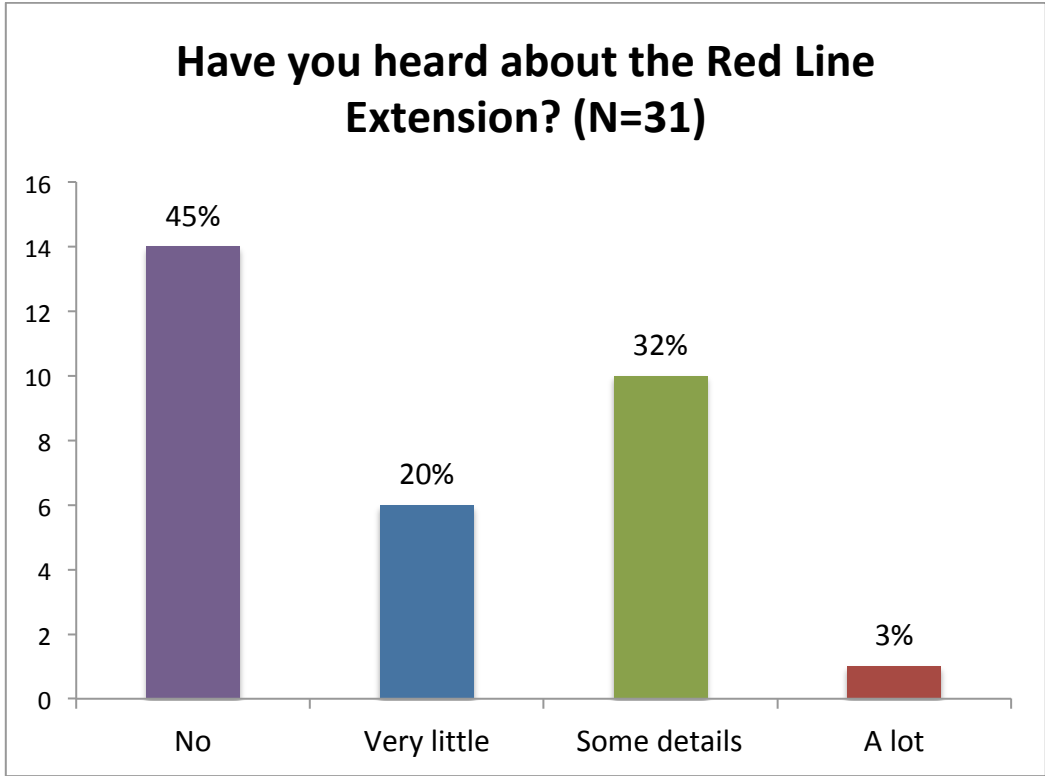
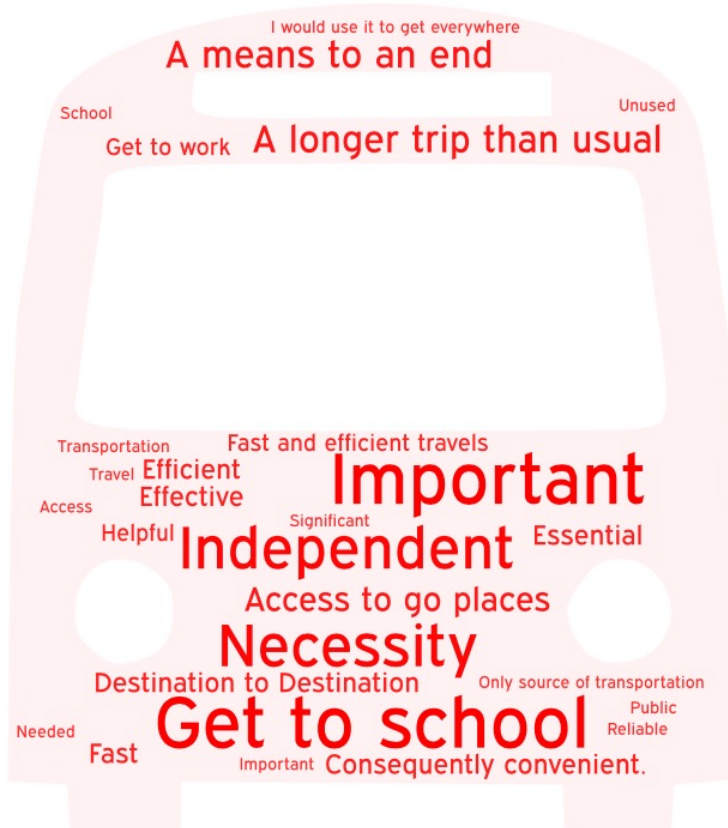

Word Cloud 2: If you had to describe what public transportation means to you in one word or a short phrase, what would you say?

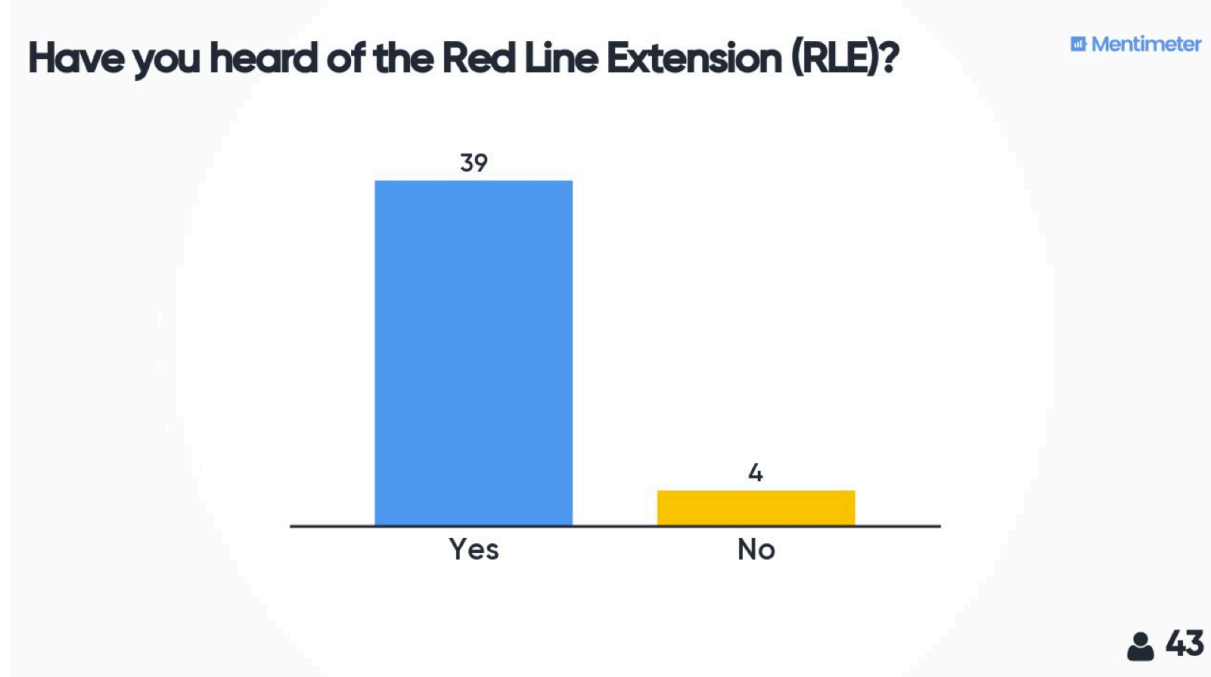


Word Cloud 3: What are negative things you've heard about the RLE? How could it impact you negatively?

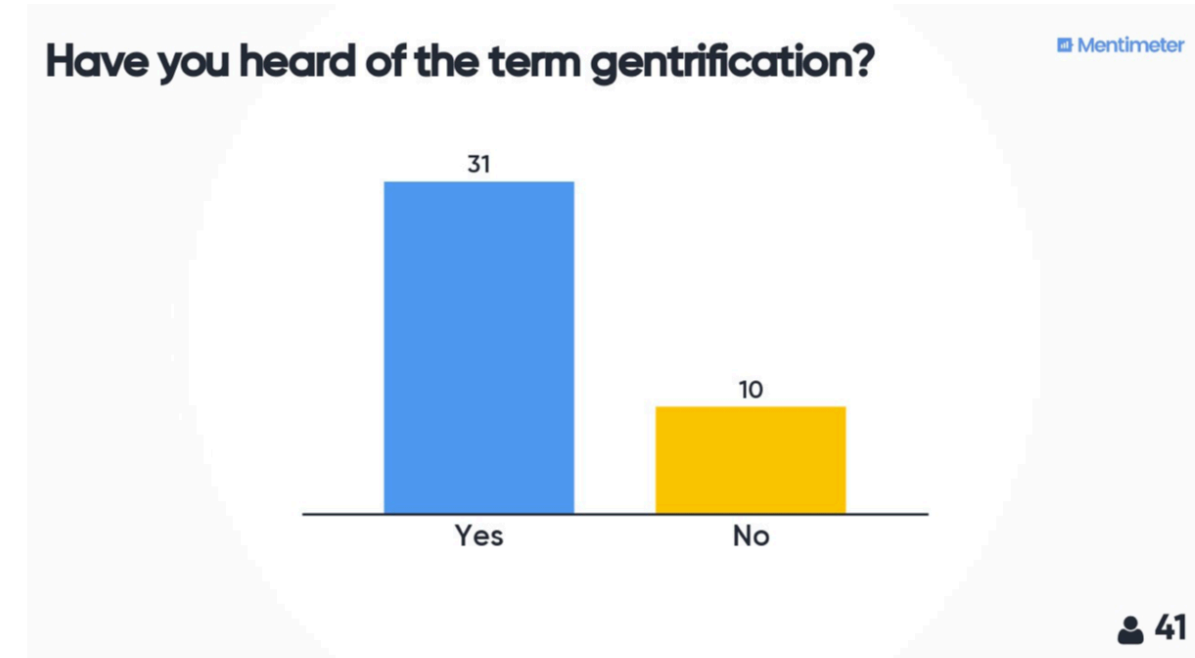


Word Cloud 4: What are positive things you've heard about the RLE? How could it impact you positively?

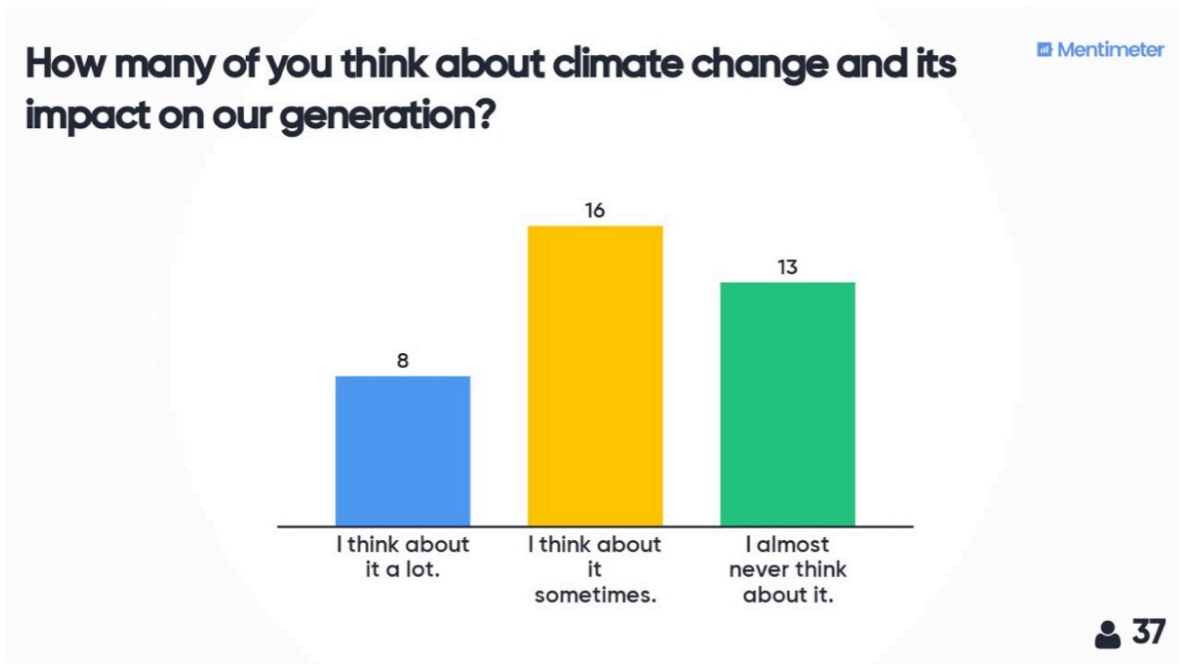

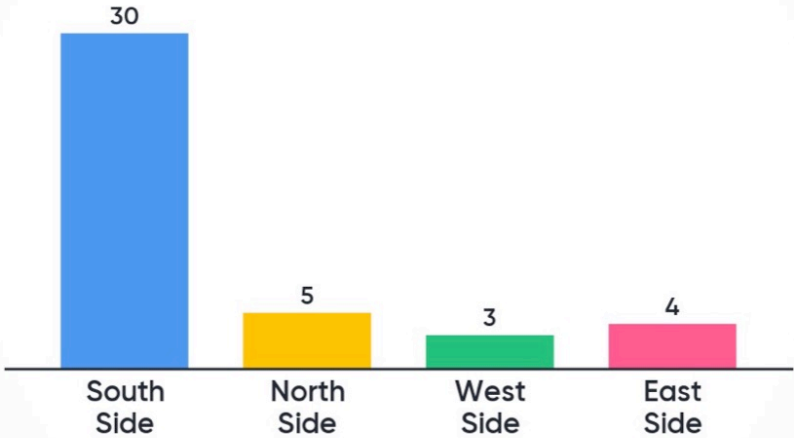
