## -----Year-In-Japan Program----- (Sept 2015-May 2016)

You will take an intensive course in Japanese language and courses in Japanese studies taught in English in Kobe, twenty minutes from Osaka and an hour from Kyoto, the classical capital of Japan. Classroom instruction is supplemented by field trips to visit historic and cultural sites.

The program is the **ONLY "Illinois Center" in Japan** So you CAN...

1. **Fulfill your residency requirement in Japan.**
2. **Earn 32 all U of I credit hours**
3. **Continue receiving most of your U of I and other forms of financial aid** in addition to scholarships through the Year in Japan program

You will have

1. **A Host Family.** During your stay, you will have your own room and enjoy morning and evening meals with your host family— Know the *real* Japan.

2. **The Resident Director** is *on site* for you! Resident Director (from one of the program consortium American Universities) will give any necessary help and academic advice to the program participants during the stay, teaches one of the courses as one of the Japanese studies faculty members, and joins the field trips with students.

3. **Three field trips** are included in the program. They cover three world cultural heritage places. Seven of eleven world cultural heritage places are just half an hour trip from Kobe.

**Year in Japan Program Cost (Estimated): Same to all students (in/out state/international)**

Currency exchange rates etc will affect the costs significantly (81yen/1dollar as of April 2012) The estimated cost of the program quoted includes most of the expenses associated with attending the program.

Study Abroad Charge (two semester tuition ( <u>32 UIUC credit hours</u> ) and fees ) ---	\$ 11,000

(6 weeks from early June to July2015)**



1. You can earn **8 U of I credit hours**.
2. You have two field trips.
3. During your stay, you will have your own room and enjoy morning and evening meals with your hostfamily.
4. The cost is around \$7,000 (including UIUC Summer Range IV Tuition, insurance, housing, two meals, books and supplies, daily transportation to and from university, two field trips and orientation on-site). This doesn't include a round trip airfare and personal expenses.
