PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This program in South Africa provides students the opportunity to study in Durban and intern in Cape Town. Coursework at the University of KwaZulu Natal's (UKZN) International School provides the foundation for understanding historical and contemporary South Africa. Students will take two courses at UKZN: Culture and Diversity in the Rainbow Nation & Zulu Language & Culture. Upon completion of coursework, students will move to Cape Town to complete a twelve-week internship. There are hundreds of internship placement opportunities in Cape Town; thus, placements will vary according to each student's academic and professional goals. By linking coursework in Durban with an internship in Cape Town, students will not only gain an understanding of current affairs in South Africa, but also valuable professional experience.
