

Dear members of the campus community,

As you know, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign has prohibited smoking on campus property since January 1, 2014. Our smoke-free campus policy has contributed to making our campus a healthy place to learn, live and work and has set an example for other colleges and universities in Illinois and beyond.

The State of Illinois' Smoke-Free Campus Act requires that all state-supported institutions of higher education prohibit smoking on campus as of July 1, 2015.

We will be making some modifications to our smoke-free campus policy in accordance with the other requirements in the act.
