
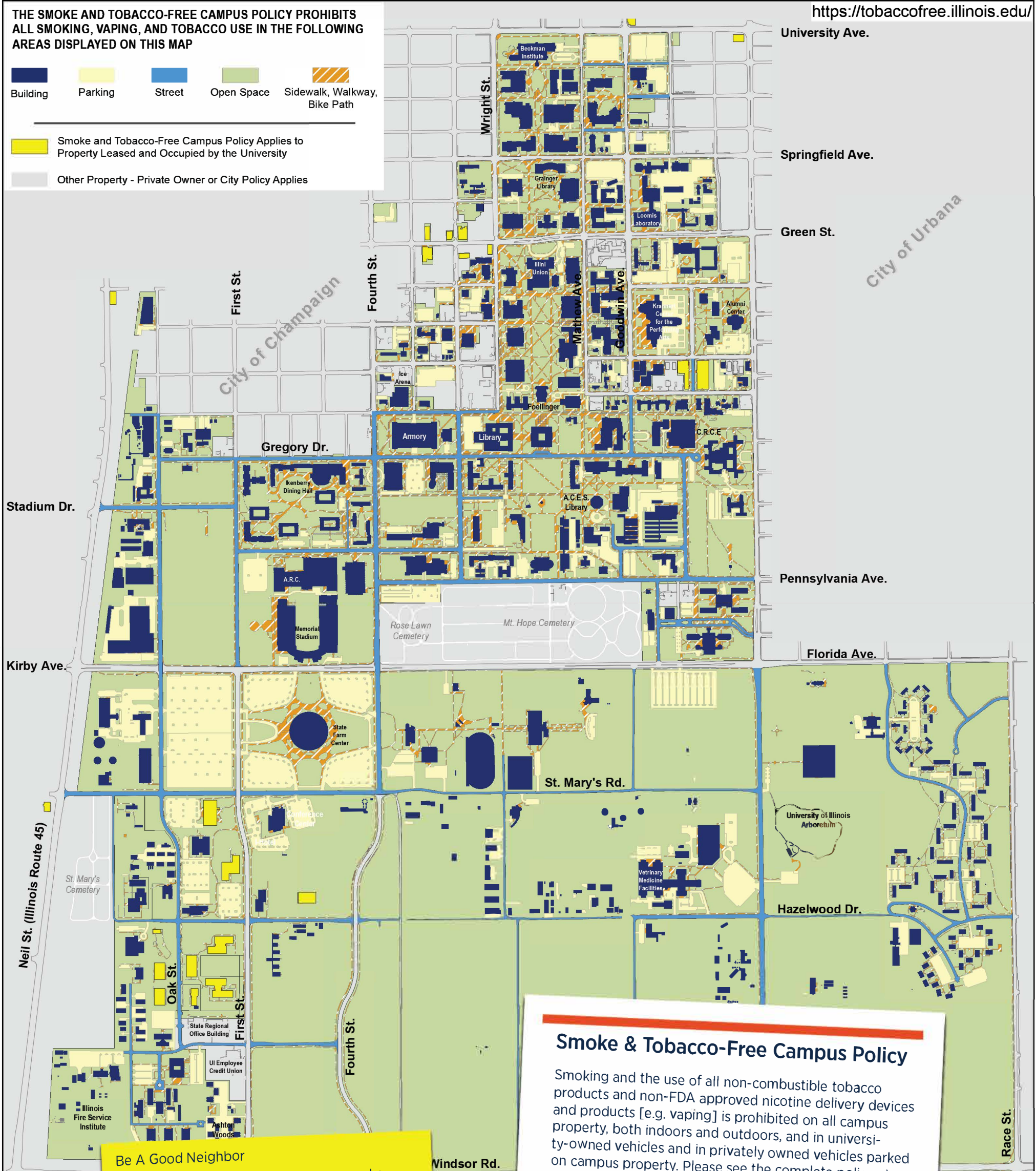

Smoke & Tobacco-Free Campus Policy

Smoking and the use of all non-combustible tobacco products and non-FDA approved nicotine delivery devices and products [e.g. vaping] is prohibited on all campus property, both indoors and outdoors, and in university-owned vehicles and in privately owned vehicles parked on campus property.
