

Smoke & Tobacco-Free Campus Policy Enforcement System

In compliance with the state of [Illinois Smoke-Free Campus Act, 110 ILCS 64/1-99](#), the Urbana campus has instituted a system of citations and fines.

University of Illinois police officers and security guards from the Division of Public Safety will now issue citations for violations of the Smoke and Tobacco-Free Campus policy.

Fines are issued according to the following schedule:

- First violation: Written warning.
- Second violation: \$25 fine.
 - This fine may be waived by completing a video educational program within 72 Hours.
- Third violation: \$50 fine.
- Fourth and subsequent violations: \$100 fine per occurrence

Individuals who observe someone smoking, vaping or using tobacco in a location prohibited by our policy should contact the University of Illinois Police at the non-emergency number, 217-333-8911. Violations must be confronted at the time they occur.
