

The Da form

The DA form is used in different contexts and to express different aspects. However, it is a the major form used to **describe** shape, size, colors, mood, attitude, look, etc. That is why it is mainly followed with an adjective.

Example: Yaw **danga rafet** = You are beautiful.

SUBJECT	DA FORM	EXAMPLES	MEANING
Man (I)	Damaa	Damaa sonn.	I am tired.
Yaw (You)	Danga	Danga rafet.	You are beautiful.
Moom (She/He/It)	Dafa	Dafa njool.	He/She is tall.
Nun (We)	Danu	Danu jaaxle.	We are anxious/worried.
Yéen (You all)	Dangéen	Dangéen gàtt.	You are short.
Ñoom (They)	Dañu	Dañu xonq.	They are red.
