

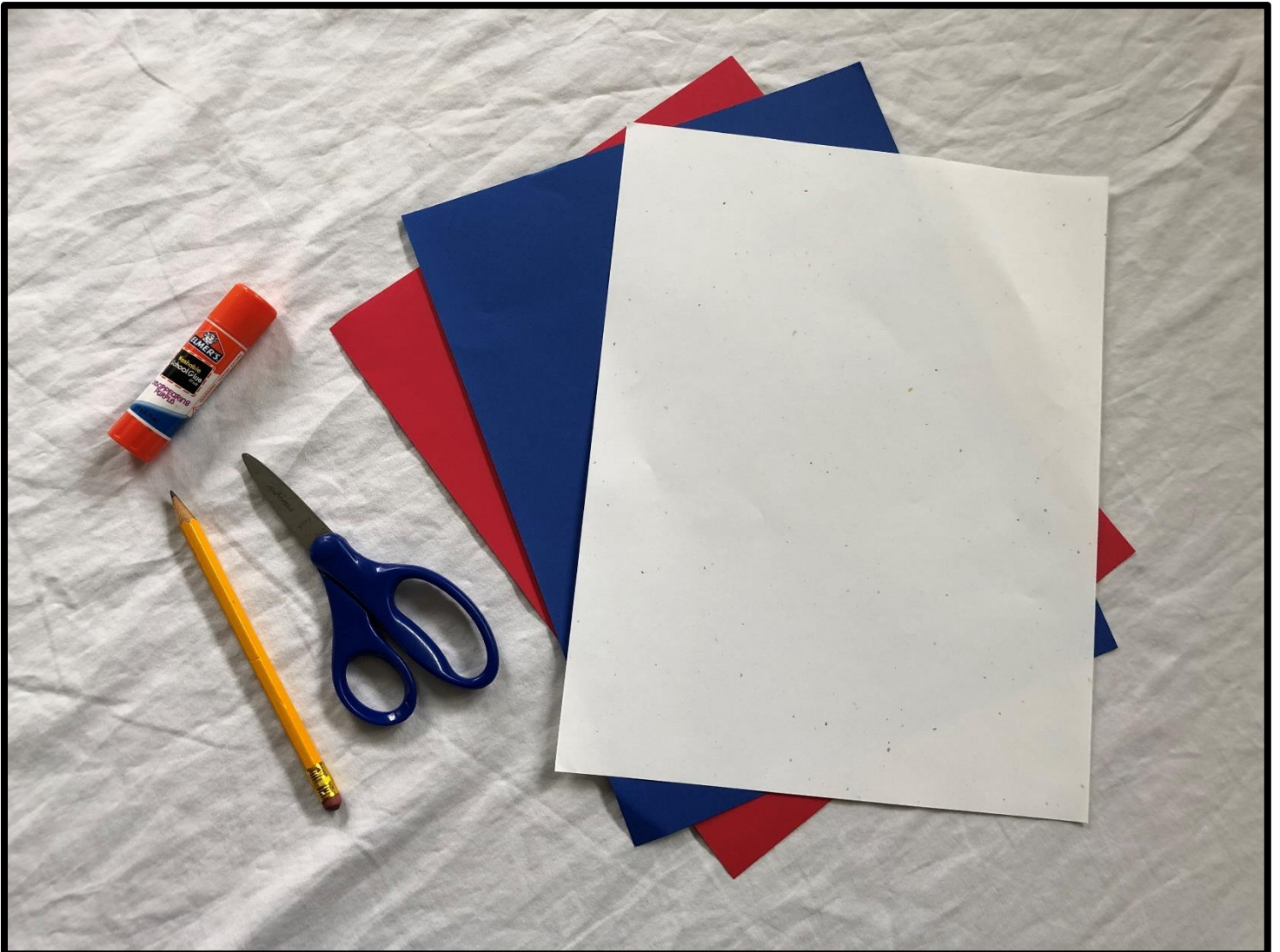
Snowflake Spiderweb Craft



Spiders are arachnids that use their venom to hunt for prey. Many spiders are considered dangerous because of their venom, but spiders very rarely bite. In this guide, we'll be making a friendly spider of our own out of construction paper.

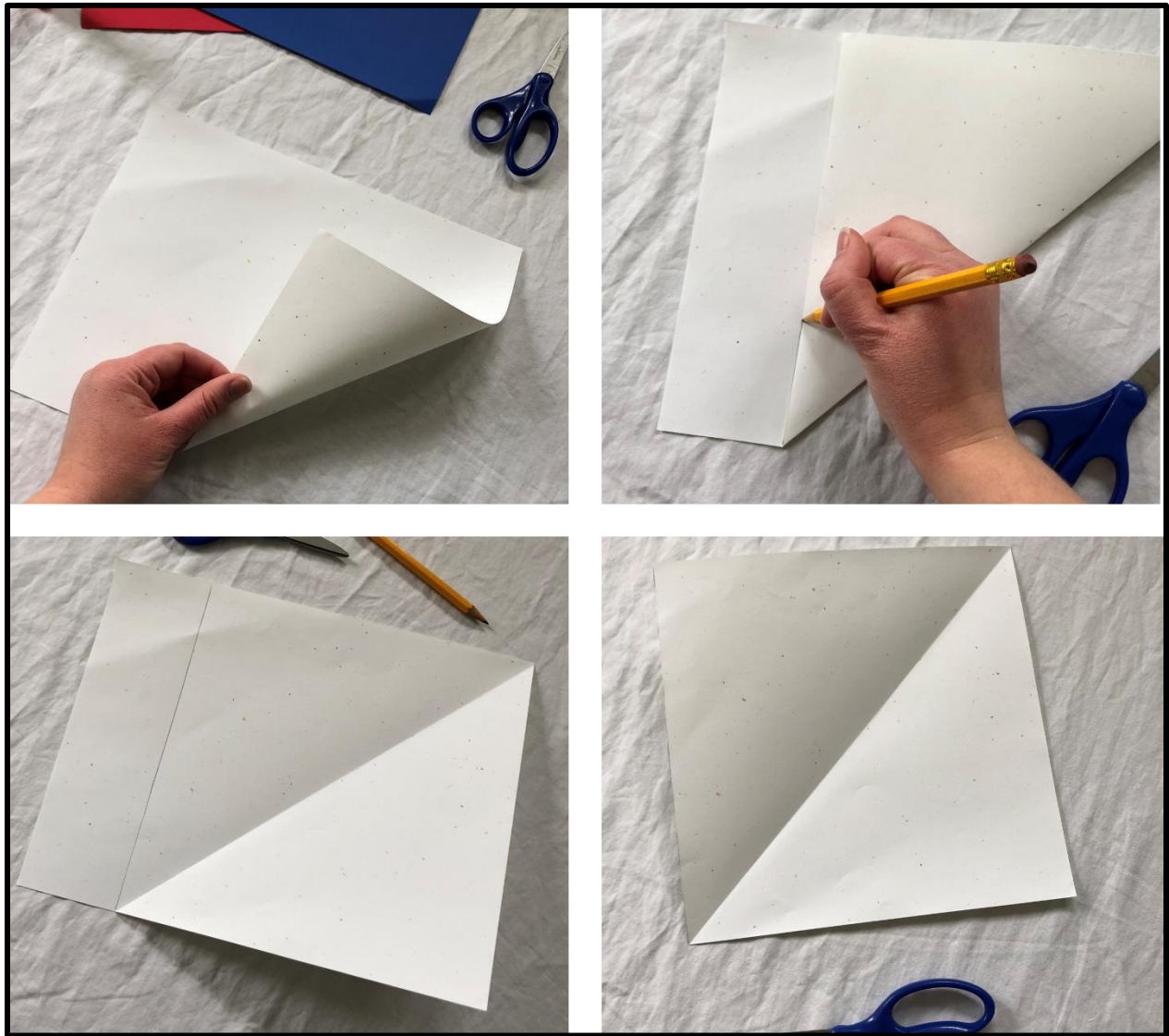
To make your own spider, you will need:

- 1. Construction Paper of different colors**
- 2. Scissors**
- 3. Glue stick**
- 4. Pencil**



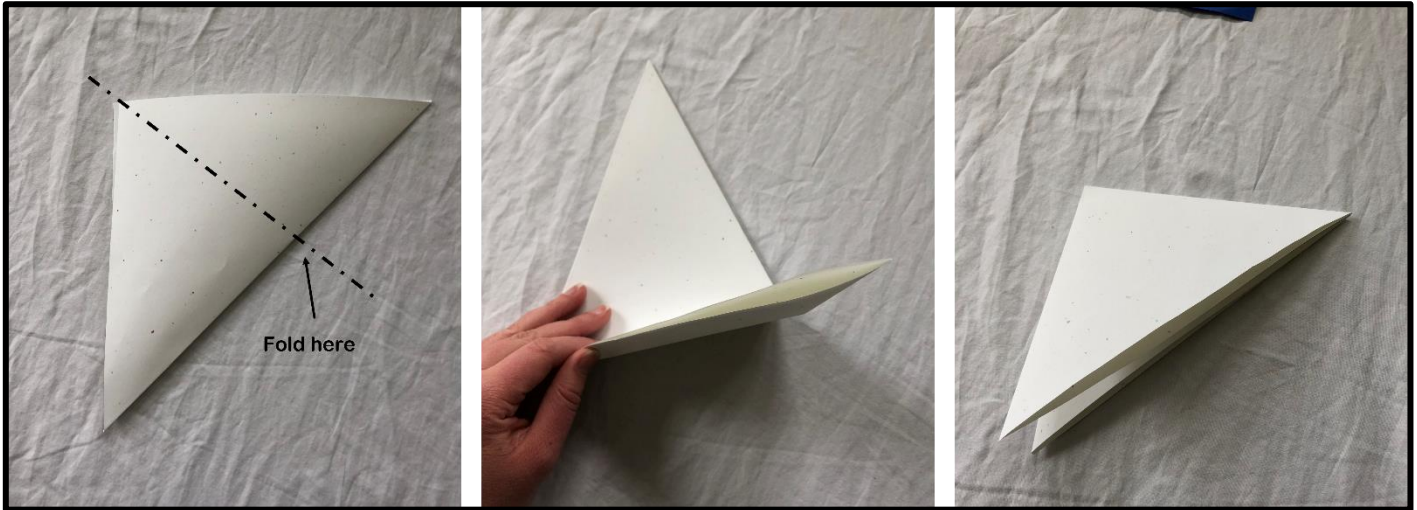
Step 1:

Fold the paper over to make a square. Make a line in pencil along the edge of the paper. Cut along the pencil line to make a square.



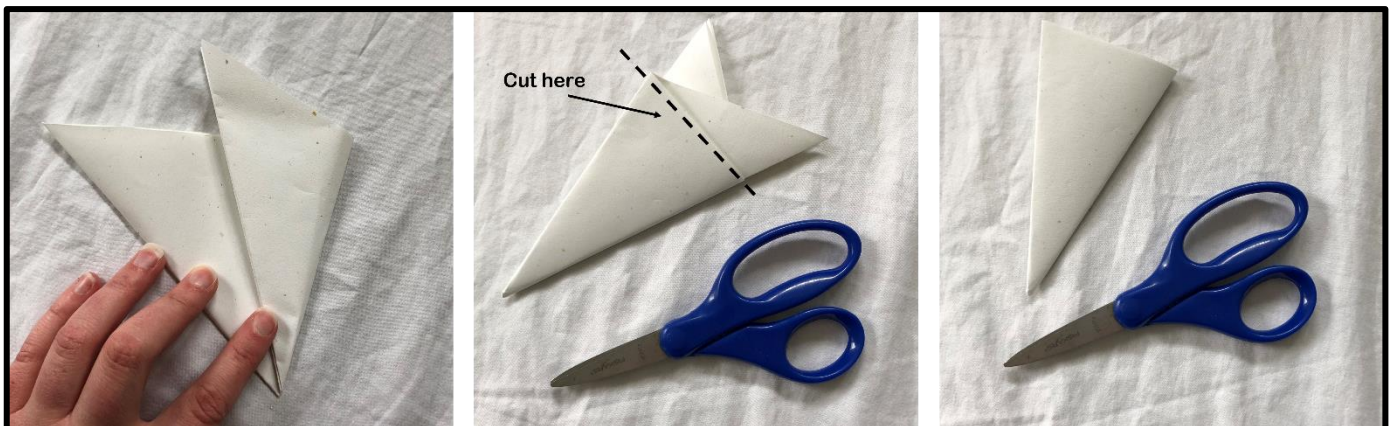
Step 2:

Fold the square in half twice



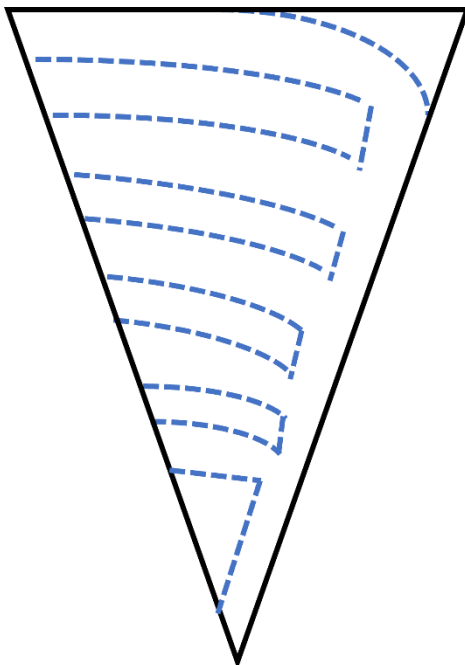
Step 3:

**Fold the paper into thirds. This might be tricky!
When done, cut off the top of the paper to make
a triangle**



Step 4:

Draw your spiderweb design onto the triangle. Then, cut it out - make sure to cut along the side of the triangle that has two edges!



Use this design here to make the perfect spiderweb!

Step 5:

Unfold your snowflake. Using a glue stick, paste it to another piece of construction paper so that it lies flat



Step 6:

Draw your spider on another piece of construction paper. Remember that spiders, unlike insects, have 8 legs!



Step 7:

Cut out your spider and draw on a face. Paste it to its web. You're done!



Did you know? Spiders can have anywhere from 2 to 8 eyes!
