

How to include a picture you took in your essay. If you took it, you don't need a citation. However, you should still put a description on it. This is a picture of a basketball player's signature in my office in Illinois (see figure 1). Since I took the photo, I don't need a citation, but I do need a caption. My caption is the description and the short sentence indicating that I took the photo.
